PLANNING FOR NORTH EAST LINK

1 — Business case

A business case examines the costs and benefits of different project options and compares them with each other, as well as a future where the project isn't built. It considers how each option performs across a number of measures: travel time savings or improved productivity for example; as well as more qualitative aspects such as community wellbeing and environmental outcomes.

3 — Approvals

North East Link will need approvals from authorities including Melbourne Water, Environment Protection Authority, VicRoads and Heritage Victoria. An independent planning panel will assess the proposal.

4 — Construction

We're talking with industry about how construction might happen: the best equipment to use; ways to minimise disruption and how we could build North East Link as quickly and efficiently as possible.
