

Upcoming day works for North East Link

Changes to site investigation work dates near you.

Previously we let you know daytime drilling works would take place Koonung Creek Trail, Joseph Street from Wednesday 14 April to Thursday 15 April. Due to changes in our work schedule, these works will now happen in April and May.

What we'll be doing

We'll be doing more soil testing in your area over the coming months. This involves:

- using a drill rig and support trucks to establish a bore hole
- drilling a bore hole 15 to 25 metres deep and 15 centimetres in diameter
- restoring the site after works are complete.

Where and when we'll be working

Koonung Creek Trail, Joseph Street, Blackburn North

- Thursday 29 April to Tuesday 4 May.

What this means for you

Drilling works will take place between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday and Tuesday. While these works will not impact your property, you may notice:

- noise generated from the high pressure water and vacuum truck, drilling rig and support trucks when in use
- all equipment is contained within security fencing.

To stay safe, please obey all instructions and signs.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
