

Works update

Temporary opening of Drysdale Street at Lower Plenty Road

Dear Resident,

Work is continuing to relocate utility services in and around Borlase Street, as part of early works for North East Link with strict health and safety measures in place.

To support these works, Drysdale Street will be temporarily opened at Lower Plenty Road from late November, with construction on the opening starting late October. The opening will ensure local access to Drysdale Street is maintained while works to relocate the water main and sewer, which requires closure of the intersection of Borlase and Drysdale streets, are completed.

The temporary opening will be closed and the road will be reinstated to its former condition after the works have been completed. These works were endorsed by local residents who were consulted by CPB Contractors in May this year and approved by Banyule City Council in September.

Construction of the temporary opening

Works will occur from **Monday 26 October** between **7am** and **6pm**, Monday to Friday; and **7am** to **1pm** on Saturdays and will take up to five weeks to complete.

Works will involve:

- A small excavator for minor earth works, a concrete saw, vacuum truck and generator
- Asphaltting, line marking and installation of road traffic signs
- Changed traffic conditions with lane closures and reduced speeds on Lower Plenty Road
- Temporary relocation of the Drysdale Street bus stop (Graham Road) to 357 Lower Plenty Road (until intersection works have been completed)
- Temporary interruptions to footpath access with detours, wayfinding signage and traffic controllers will assist pedestrians.

Intermittent noise may be experienced, however all efforts will be made to reduce impacts for our neighbours.

Our community engagement team will be available to assist residents during the works and provide updates. Safety is our priority and we ask your assistance with referring to any safety instructions and signage.

We look forward to starting these works and thank you for your feedback during our consultation earlier this year.
