## Day works

### Simpson Barracks, Yallambie

Early works for the North East Link Project are well underway with the removal of 95 above and below ground services ahead of major construction on Victoria's biggest road project from 2021. As part of these works, land within Simpson Barracks, an Australian Army facility operated by the Department of Defence, will be prepared for future construction in the area.

### What we will be doing

Preparation works at Simpson Barracks includes:

- Installing security perimeter fencing
- Constructing new buildings, car parks, access roads and a new entrance
- Moving essential services, including a water main connection from Greensborough Road
- Demolishing existing Defence buildings and structures
- Earthworks, vegetation removal and salvage where possible
- Relocating the ANZAC Day service memorial

Base security will be maintained at all times during these works.

### When and where we are working

#### Simpson Barracks, Yallambie

Works begin from **early July** and continue until **mid-December 2020**.

These are day works from **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **7am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

### What you may experience

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews and construction vehicles operating around Simpson Barracks
- Intermittent periods of noise and dust, which will be monitored and controlled throughout the works
- Traffic management around any works happening near a road.

An independent arborist and wildlife handler will be on site to supervise unavoidable vegetation removal and transition wildlife safely. 'No-go' zones and fenced off areas will be established to protect remaining vegetation and wildlife.

Safety is our priority and we ask your assistance in observing and complying with safety instructions and works signage.
