Day Works

Cultural heritage investigations near Creek Bend Reserve, Rosanna

Works have started to build the missing link in Melbourne's freeway network. We're moving almost 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewerage and telecommunication to make way for North East Link.

As part of these works, we are required to perform further investigations in the area to build on extensive Aboriginal cultural heritage assessments carried out for the North East Link Project Environment Effects Statement.

What we'll be doing

Teams of Aboriginal cultural heritage specialists, including members of the Wurundjeri Woi Wurrung Aboriginal Corporation, are currently conducting an archaeological survey in the area.

This includes:

- Installing temporary fencing around the survey area
- Using both hand tools and an excavator to carefully salvage and remove a layer of surface materials
- The salvaged surface matter will be relocated to a facility for processing by hand to search for artefacts
- Reinstating the survey area when investigations are completed.

Where and when we'll be working

Creek Bend Reserve, Rosanna, near Lower Plenty Road

These investigations will continue from **Monday 12 October** for up to five weeks. Work hours are from **7am** to **6pm**, Monday to Friday; and Saturdays, **7am** to **1pm**. Please note dates are subject to change.

Please note vehicles will be accessing Creek Bend Reserve using McCrae Road, Rosanna.

Temporary changes to River Gum Walk

The River Gum Walk shared user path will be closed during these works. A pedestrian detour will be in place via McCrae Road, Leura Avenue, Cantala Avenue, and Lower Plenty Road.

Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance by dismounting from your bike before you reach the survey area and obeying all instructions and signage.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

Health and safety

North East Link Project works are progressing safely under the current Second Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.

You may notice an increase of workers on Victoria's Big Build projects as restrictions on construction sites start to ease. Large-scale public infrastructure projects are critical and strict COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all project sites across Victoria.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority. Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition for Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place as well as increased hygiene practices.

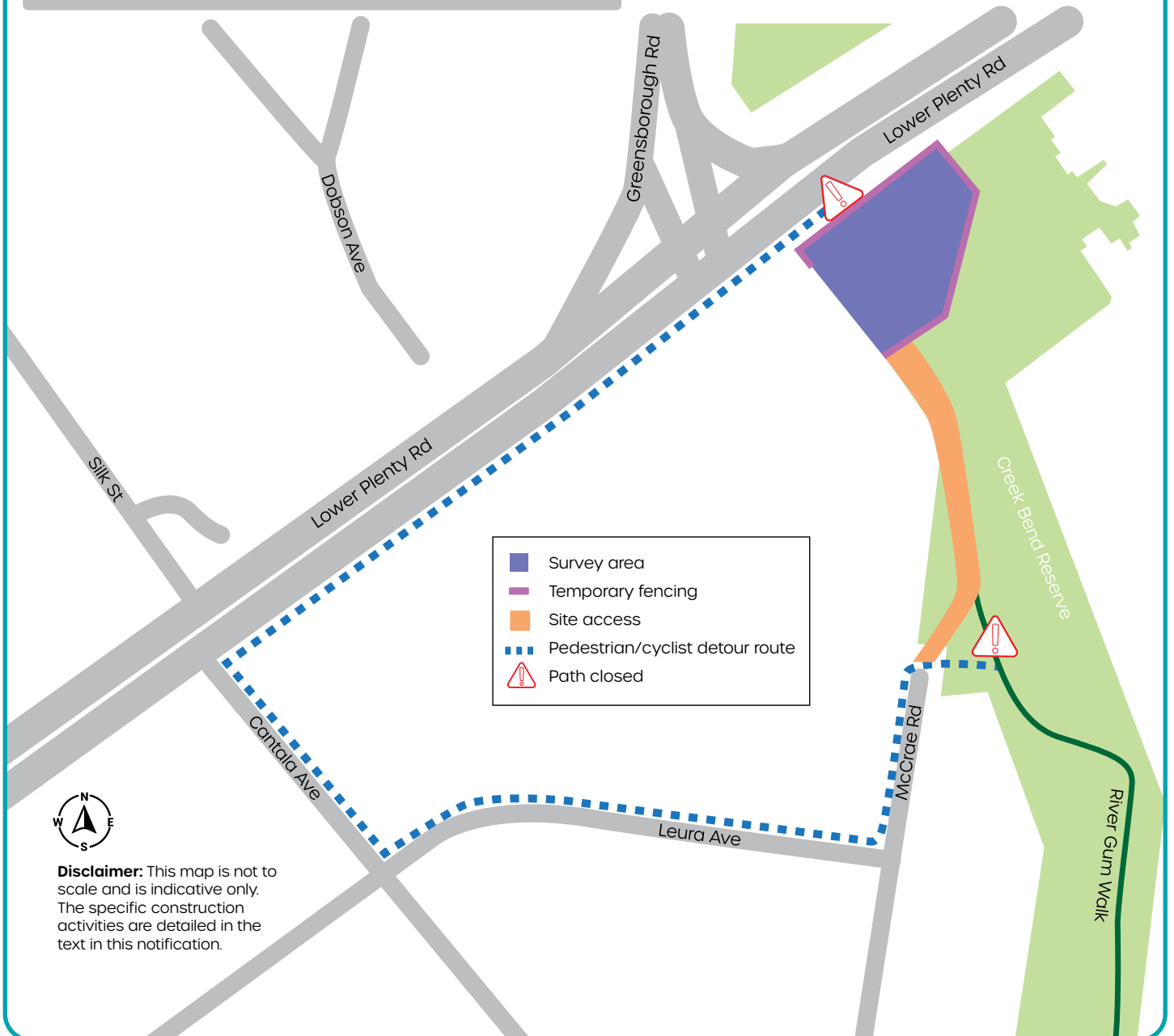
