Day works

What we'll be doing

A work crew will be dismantling the vacant properties at 276, 250 and 238 Greensborough Road, Macleod.

This will involve:

- Installing temporary safety fencing around the worksite
- Implementing environmental controls such as tree protection zones, silt traps and dust suppression
- Removal of vegetation under the supervision of independent arborists and wildlife handlers.

Where and when we'll be working

276, 250 and 238 Greensborough Road, between Lenola Street and Yallambie Road, Macleod.

These works will take place between Wednesday 11 November and Tuesday 1 December.

These are day works from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**; and if needed **Saturday 7am to 1pm**.

What you may experience

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews and construction vehicles in the area
- Noise from plant and equipment such as excavators, tippers and bobcats
- Water spray will be used as required to suppress any dust
- Hygienists in protective clothing.

Pedestrian footpath access will be maintained with temporary fencing separating the works. Traffic controllers will be in place to guide you safely through the area.

Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works. Safety is our priority and we ask your assistance with following any instructions and signage.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

Managing safety during construction

You may notice workers in specialist protective wear to ensure that they are safely managing any hazardous material found on site. These specialists use methods designed to ensure the safety of workers and residents.

All hazardous materials found on any of our project sites, such as asbestos, is managed in accordance with strict Environment Performance Requirements and the relevant environmental and, health and safety legislation in order to protect workers, the community, wildlife and the environment.

All hazardous material will be disposed of in accordance with Environment Protection Authority (EPA) requirements at sites licensed to review hazardous waste.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority.

Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception - such as a medical condition or for Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place as well as increased hygiene practices.
