Day/night works update

Site investigations will be happening near you soon as part of planning work for North East Link.

What we'll be doing

From **Monday 12 April 2021**, CPB Contractors will be identifying underground utility services and undertaking geotechnical investigations in and around the Koonung Creek Reserve including Thompsons Road, Kampman Street and Sandra Street. These works will take approximately **eight weeks** to complete and will involve:

- Using hand held scanners, radars to locate services and hand augers to take soil samples.
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to carefully expose underground services and verify their location. This involves using high pressure water and a vacuum to dig/pothole. This includes the use of a concrete saw to cut into pavement.
- Using a drill rig and support trucks to establish a bore hole
- Drilling a bore hole 20 to 25 metres deep and 15 centimetres in diameter
- Restoring areas after investigations have been completed
- Temporary traffic condition changes including local road closures, detours, lane closures, reduced speeds, traffic and pedestrian management as required.

When and where we are working?

From **Monday 12 April 2021** for up to eight weeks, works will occur at the following locations:

Day works as follows:

- **Koonung Creek Reserve**, for up to one week
- **Kampman Street**, up to three days
- **Thompsons Road Service Road**, up to four days with a shifting road closure. Local access will be maintained.

Working hours: Mondays to Fridays, 7am to 5pm; Saturdays, 7am to 1pm.

Night works as follows:


- **Thompsons Road and Sandra Street**, up to a week with lane closures and reduced speeds on Thompsons Road, between Hugo Street and the Eastern Freeway. Two way traffic access will be maintained on Thompsons Road. Access may be restricted to Manningham Club and Hotel this will be advised in advance.
- **Eastern Freeway on-ramp**, up to a week with single lane closures on the ramp.

Working hours: Monday to Fridays, 6pm to 6am

What this means for you

During these works you may notice:

- Our crew working in the area
- Noise from large equipment including excavators, concrete cutting saws, a drill rig, and a vacuum truck
- Temporary changes to traffic conditions, including road closures, lane closures, detours, traffic controllers directing traffic and reduced speed limits
- Temporary changes at times to pedestrian and cycle access with traffic management in place to assist with wayfinding signage in place
- While night works occur on Thompsons Road and the Eastern Freeway on ramp, traffic conditions will change with lane closures. Traffic management will be in place with detour signage and traffic controllers to assist.
- Property access will be maintained. There may be times when access to driveways may be interrupted or restricted and if that is required adjacent properties will be notified in advance.

Night works

Works on Thompsons Road and the Eastern Freeway on ramp will be completed at night. Completing these works at night is safer for the community and our workers and reduces traffic impacts.

Adjacent residents directly impacted by the works will be contacted by the team prior to works commencing.

Our community engagement team will be available to assist residents during these works. Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance with following instructions, signage and maintaining social distancing during current restrictions.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
