## Day Works

### Extension to cultural heritage investigations near Creek Bend Reserve, Rosanna

We have been carrying out cultural heritage investigations in the area since July 2020 to build on extensive assessments carried out for the North East Link Project Environment Effects Statement. These investigations will now continue following delays as a result of Stage 4 restrictions and workforce reductions.

#### What we will be doing

Small groups of Aboriginal cultural heritage specialists, including members of the Wurundjeri Woi Wurrung Aboriginal Corporation, will continue to conduct an archaeological survey in the area.

This includes:

- Accessing Creek Bend Reserve via McCrae Road, Rosanna
- Using hand tools to excavate surface materials
- Searching for artefacts using non-invasive methods
- Reinstating the survey area when investigations are completed.

#### Where and when we are working

##### Creek Bend Reserve, Rosanna, near Lower Plenty Road

Investigations will continue from **Wednesday 16 September** until **3 October 2020** for up to three days each week. Work hours are from **7am** to **6pm**, Monday to Friday. Please note dates are subject to change.

The River Gum Walk shared user path will remain open to pedestrians and cyclists while these investigations are carried out. Safety is our priority and we ask your assistance by dismounting from your bike before you reach the survey area and obey all instructions and signage.

**We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.**

The North East Link Project is an important state infrastructure project. Early works will continue under stage 4 restrictions, with strict health and safety measures in place.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are continuing to focus on managing the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.
