Day Works

Investigative works

Early works for the North East Link Project are well underway with the removal of around 100 above and below ground services ahead of major construction on Victoria's biggest road project from 2021. As part of these works CPB contractors are completing service locating before construction of the Yarra East Main sewer.

What we'll be doing

CPB Contractors is identifying underground utility services and completing geotechnical investigations, which includes:

- Scanning the ground to locate services with handheld electronic equipment
- Using high-pressure water and vacuum to carefully expose underground services and verify their location
- Excavating small pits to expose the service
- Reinstating the work site when investigations are completed.

Where and when we'll be working

- **Bulleen Park Oval No. 1, 189 Bulleen Road, Bulleen.**

These investigations will take place on **Thursday 22 October** to **Friday 30 October 2020**.

Please note dates are subject to change. These are day works from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

What this means for you

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Noise from plant and equipment, such as a vacuum truck, excavator and light vehicles
- Dust from the work site.

Mitigation measures, which may include noise blankets and noise barriers, will be used to minimise local disruptions. Traffic controllers will be in place near the works to guide you safely through the area.

Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works.

To stay safe, please obey all instructions and signs.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

The North East Link Project is an important state infrastructure project. Early works are continuing in line with Government restrictions, with strict health and safety measures in place.
