Day and night works

Telecommunication works on Greensborough Road

From October 2020, relocation works will continue along Greensborough Road to make way for the North East Link.

What we are doing

Telecommunication works

CPB Contractors and the telecommunications service provider will be installing underground cable along Greensborough Road between Erskine Road and Watsonia Road.

Works will include:

- Digging a trench in the nature strip on the western side of Greensborough Road
- Drilling beneath Greensborough Road from Simpson Barracks
- Minor vegetation removal
- Temporary access restrictions for adjacent driveways, however we will contact impacted residents before works begin.

Where and when we are working

Day works

Greensborough Road, between Erskine Road and Watsonia Road, Macleod.

These works will take place during October and November. Working hours are **7am to 6pm** on weekdays and **7am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

Night works

Greensborough Road, between Erskine Road and Cooley Avenue, Macleod.

These works will take place from 21 October to 30 November 2020. Working hours are **7pm to 5:30am**, with traffic management setup from 7pm each night.

Please note dates and times are subject to change.

What this means for you

During these works you may notice:

- Noise from vehicles and equipment
- Overnight lane closures and reduced speeds on Greensborough Road
- Temporary footpath closures along Greensborough Road
- Pedestrian and traffic management signage in the area.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruptions for local residents as much as possible. Please contact our community engagement team if you would like to speak with us about these works.

Safety is our priority and we ask your assistance with following all instructions and signage.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

North East Link works are progressing safely under the current Second Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.

You may notice an increase of workers on Victoria's Big Build projects as restrictions on construction sites start to ease. Large-scale public infrastructure projects are critical and strict COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all project sites across Victoria.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority. Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition for Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place as well as increased hygiene practices.
