Day Works

Investigations and fencing works along M80 Ring Road

We're continuing works on North East Link with strict health and safety measures in place. From late September for up to three weeks, we will be carrying out investigative and fencing works within the road reserve along the M80 Ring Road between Plenty Road and the Greensborough Bypass.

What we are doing

Geotechnical and service investigations near the mobile tower at the Greensborough Bypass

Identifying the location of underground services and taking ground samples, which includes:

- Accessing the work site via Goolgung Grove, Greensborough
- Scanning the ground to locate services with handheld electronic equipment
- Carefully exposing services to verify their location using high-pressure water and a vacuum truck
- Using drilling rigs to make bore holes and excavators to dig test pits
- Reinstating the work site when investigations are completed.

Temporary fencing near Goolgung Grove, Greensborough

Temporary fencing will protect an identified cultural heritage exclusion zone during upcoming works in the area. Fencing panels will be installed on both sides of the shared user path near Goolgung Grove. The shared user path will remain open. Site access during installation will be provided via Goolgung Grove, Greensborough.

Hoarding installation along M80 Ring Road

Strengthening the existing chain mesh fencing and installing additional hoarding along the M80 Ring Road between Plenty Road and the Greensborough Bypass to prepare for North East Link construction.

The North East Link Project is an important state infrastructure project. Early works are continuing in line with Government restrictions, with strict health and safety measures in place.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are continuing to focus on managing the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

These works will happen over **three weeks** between **Tuesday 29 September** to **Monday 19 October 2020**.

These are day works between **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **7am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

Please note dates and times are subject to change.

What you may experience

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Noise from vehicles and equipment, including a drilling rig, excavator and vacuum truck for geotechnical and service investigations
- Dust near the work site
- Pedestrian traffic control on the shared user path while vehicles and equipment are moved nearby
- Temporary fencing and hoarding placed on existing fencing.
