

# Works notification

October - November 2020



## Day and night works

Site investigations are happening near you soon as part of North East Link

### What we'll be doing

#### Night time pavement investigation works will involve:

- Using a road saw to cut a rectangular section in the road pavement
- Removing road materials using a small excavator
- Measuring the strength and depth of ground conditions by conducting a Dynamic Pressure Test (DPT), using a hand operated device
- Excavating to a maximum depth of 1.5m and collecting soil samples
- Reinstating the road surface using asphalt laying equipment and leveling the surface using a hand operated plate compactor.

#### Koonung Reserve geotechnical and soil investigation day works will involve:

- Using a high pressure water and vacuum truck to locate underground services
- Using a drill rig and support trucks to establish bore holes
- Drilling bore holes 35 to 50 metres deep and 15 centimetres in diameter
- Using a hand arguer to excavate small holes 2 to 10 metres deep and 8 to 10 centimetres in diameter
- Collecting soil samples to understand conditions underground
- Restoring the site after works are complete.

### Where and when we'll be working

#### Thompsons Road, Bulleen between the Bulleen Road entry ramp and Kampman Street.

- Sunday 4 October to Tuesday 6 October

We will be working from 7pm to 5am, Sunday to Tuesday.

#### Geotechnical and soil investigations in Koonung Reserve, Bulleen between Thompsons Road and Kampman Street.

- Monday 12 October to Thursday 19 November, excluding weekends

We will be working from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday.

### Carrying out works at night reduces traffic impacts and is safer for our workers and local residents.

These works will not impact your property and access will be maintained. We will reinstate the work areas once works are complete.

### We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

The North East Link Project is an important state infrastructure project. Early works are continuing in line with Government restrictions, with strict health and safety measures in place.

Our workforce numbers across Victoria's Big Build have already been significantly reduced to support directions from the Chief Health Officer.

We are continuing to focus on managing the number of staff and visitors attending our worksites, as well as implementing preventative measures to ensure safety.

Safety measures across the site include temperature screening, additional protective equipment including masks, daily health screening of workers, enhanced cleaning, staggered shifts and break times, and physical distancing.

### Night works:

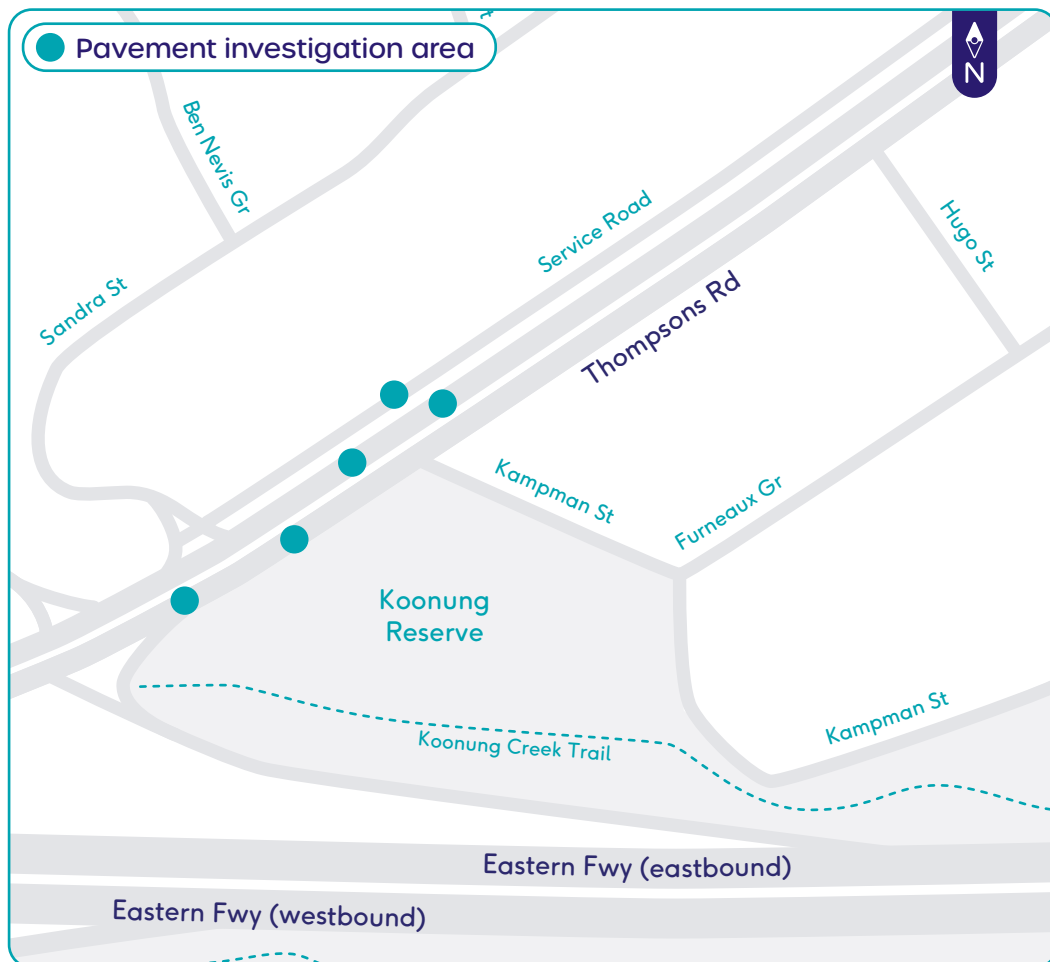
- Noise due to road saw, small excavator, asphalt laying equipment, plate compactor and site vehicles when in use
