## Day works

### Relocating the Pressure Reducing Station to Coleen Street Reserve

We're continuing works on North East Link with strict health and safety measures in place. From early November, we will begin working in Coleen Street Reserve to relocate the Water Pressure Reducing station (PRS) from the corner of Borlase and Drysdale streets.

#### What we'll be doing

##### Water supply infrastructure works

CPB Contractors will be building a new PRS in Coleen Street Reserve, which includes earthworks, structural works and infrastructure fit out.

Works will involve:

- Accessing Coleen Street Reserve and the Melbourne Water pipe track via Borlase Street
- Vegetation removal and pruning under the supervision of arborists and wildlife handlers
- Locating underground services near the works area
- Securing the site with temporary fencing
- Excavating adjacent to the Melbourne Water pipe track
- Pouring cement to establish base foundations and walls
- Laying underground water pipes and power cables
- Installing sheds and other water supply assets.

#### Where and when we'll be working

**Coleen Street Reserve and the Melbourne Water pipe track, Yallambie.**

These works will take place from **5 November 2020** to **February 2021**. Working hours are **7am to 6pm** on weekdays and **7am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

Please note dates are subject to change.

#### What this means for you

During these works you may notice:

- Restricted public access to Coleen Street Reserve and the Melbourne Water pipe track
- Noise from vehicles and equipment, including an excavator, vacuum truck and concrete saw
- Temporary road closures on Drysdale and Borlase streets with local detours in place
- Pedestrian and traffic management signage in the area.

North East Link works are progressing safely under the current Second Step restrictions in metropolitan Melbourne.

You may notice an increase of workers on Victoria's Big Build projects as restrictions on construction sites start to ease. Large-scale public infrastructure projects are critical and strict COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all project sites across Victoria.

The health and safety of our workforce and community remains our top priority. Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition for Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place as well as increased hygiene practices.
